Event Description: The GLA 5K and Fun Run is a fundraising event, open to the public, to support after school

programming at Greenwood Leadership Academy, a PK-3 partnership school in North Tulsa. The event will include multiple community sponsorships and will be accompanied by "Health Hub" event to promote opportunities for healthy living and greater access to healthcare for our North Tulsa community. The one mile Fun Run will begin at approximately 8AM and will is tentatively scheduled to follow a looped trail in the wooded area immediately behind the school. The 5K will begin at approximately 8:45AM and will follow Seminole Street westward from the school to the intersection of W. Tecumseh St. and N. Gilcrease Museum Road. Runners will take Gilcrease northward to W. Apache St, before turning right and running east along Apache to Metropolitan Baptist Church (1228 W. Apache). At the entrance to the church, runners will turn around and follow the route back to the finish line at Greenwood Leadership Academy (1789 W. Seminole) where the race began. The race is expected to be completed by 10AM.

Vendor Parking	Vendors will park in the lot immediately behind the school (Greenwood Leadership Academy), on the school grounds. Vendors may begin arriving to park and set up starting at 6:30am
Racer/Attendee Parking	Racers/attendees will park in the parking lot at Transformation Church (pending agreement with church). Racers/attendees will then be able to take the sidewalk from the church to the starting line of the 5K/entrance to the Health Hub event.

Race Course Map and Details:


The race will begin at Greenwood Leadership Academy (1789 W. Seminole Street) and continue along the following route:

- West on W. Seminole Street for approximately 550 meters
- North on N. 24th W. Ave for approximately 91 meters
- West on W. Tecumseh St for approximately 110 meters
- North on N. Gilcrease Museum Road for approximately 550 meters
- East on W. Apache St. for approximately 1.1km

Racers will turn around at Metropolitan Baptist Church (1228 W. Apache) and complete the race be following the route back:

- West on W. Apache St. for approximately 1.1km
- South on N. Gilcrease Museum Road for approximately 550 meters
- East on W. Tecumseh St for approximately 110 meters
- South on N. 24th W. Ave for approximately 91 meters
- East on W. Seminole Street for approximately 550 meters

Race Site Map and Details:

The main site/venue for the race will be Greenwood Leadership Academy (1789 W. Seminole Street, Tulsa).

An EMSA ambulance will be stationed on standby in the parking lot on the west side of the building. The ambulance will have multiple emergency exits from the race start site, through N. 24th W. Ave and N. Waco Ave. via W. Seminole St.

Mobile clinics are scheduled to be parked in the front parking lot of the building for the concurrent "health hub" event happening inside of the building.

Parking for the race is tentatively scheduled to be at a nearby church parking-lot. Back up parking is available in the back of the school.

The DJ/event emcee will be stationed in the front parking lot near the first aid station.

The start/finish line will be on West Seminole Street, immediately adjacent to the parking lot on the south side of the school's main entrance.

Multiple restrooms are available inside of the building.

Trash receptacles will be placed inside of the building, at the front of the building and at the start/finish line.
