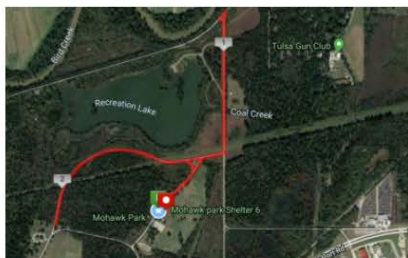

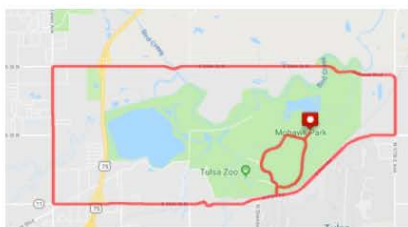
COURSE



The Chris Brown Duathlon starts with a 5K run on paved streets within Mohawk Park. All streets are closed to public traffic. The course is a flat out-and-back. There is an aid station at the turn around and the course is easy to navigate. The third leg of the Chris Brown follows this same course.

In 2019 the run course was modified due to flood damage inside Mohawk Park. There are two turn-arounds before you return to the transition area. Pay attention to the course marshal's instructions.



In 2019 the bike course was modified due to flood damage inside Mohawk Park. The bike course is scenic tour of some of Tulsa's rural streets. All streets are open to traffic and cyclists must obey all traffic laws. Volunteers and law enforcement will be on the course to assist with traffic and instructions.

- Turn Right out of Shelter 6
- Follow Choctaw Dr and Chicksaw Dr to exit park - Slow down for railroad tracks
- Turn Right (West) onto E 36th Street
- Turn Right (North) onto N Lewis Ave
- Turn Right (East) onto E 56th St N
- Follow 56th St as it becomes Mohawk Blvd
- Turn Right (South) on N Mingo Rd/N 97th E Ave
- Turn Right (West) on E 46th St N
- Turn Right back into Park - Slow down for railroad tracks
- Take first Right back to transition - Cherokee Dr

FRIENDS AND FAMILY

The Chris Brown Duathlon provides many opportunities for friends and family to watch you perform. The transition area near Shelter 6 is a great place to watch and cheer participants as they transition from one segment to another. Athletes make two loops on the bike course on the main road near Shelter 6. This is a great place to see all the competitors in action. The finish line is next to the transition area.

Spectators are asked to stay off the course to reduce traffic. Spectators are not allowed to provide any aid or assistance to participants during the race. Pacers are not allowed on the course at any time. Outside support will result in automatic disqualification. More cowbell is always welcome.
