TERMINATION OF STAGE 1 – VOLUNTARY WATER USE RESTRICTIONS

WHEREAS, the current water system delivery as filed with the City Clerk is 210 million gallons per day (mgd);

WHEREAS, on July 31, 2012 the Mayor determined that on July 29, 2012 and July 30, 2012 water usage exceeded ninety-four (94%) of the City of Tulsa's ability to deliver potable water to its customers by means of its water system creating conditions that may have been harmful to the public, health, safety and welfare, and subsequently ordered the implementation of Stage 1- Voluntary Water Use Restrictions;

WHEREAS, from the dates of August 9, 2012 through August 12, 2012 water usage has been below ninety-four (94%) of the City of Tulsa's ability to deliver potable water to its customers by means of its water system;

WHEREAS, there have been lower temperatures with some rain, and a predication of temperatures in the 90's with a chance of rain through the next week;

By virtue of the power vested in me as Mayor of the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, it is hereby ordered:

Section 1. TERMINATION OF STAGE 1 – VOLUNTARY WATER USE RESTRICTIONS



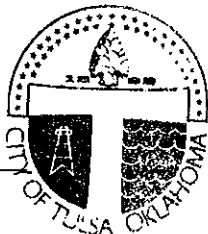
Section 2. EFFECTIVE DATE: This Order shall take effect immediately.


