






Start/Finish: On Victory Christian's Campus at the main entrance. Located at the water meter cover that is 14 meters south of the church steeple. (36.051904 -95.958660)

1K/4k: On Wheeling Ave, at the flag pole in front of the Lakes Apartments Leasing Office. (GPS 36.0473 -95.9644)

<u>2k/3K</u>: On River Parks Trail, at the first light pole south of the seating area on the curve of the trail N of the Joe Creek Crossing. (GPS 36.0491 -95.9714) <u>Turnaround</u>: On River Parks Trail, at the seating area at Helmerich Park. Located 2.5 meters N of the N edge of the side walk that branches off to Helmerich Park. Park in the river spirit casino lot, at the north corner of the lot. Walk from the lot onto the trail and walk north. Stand on the corner where the runners turn and run toward the river. Stand on the walking/running lane side and not on the bike lane side.

Cheer for the runners passing by. Do not block the bike lane. The Race 4 Victory participants will be identifiable by their race bibs that are clipped to their shirt. You are the 1 mile marker (roughly). On their way back, they just have 1 more

ITEMS YOU NEED TO TAKE WITH YOU:

- WATER COOLERS
- 5K TURNAROUND SIGNS
- TRASH BAGS
- POP-UP TENT

Pass out water and cheer for runners. Half marathon runners will run past you and then start passing you again around 90 minutes later, roughly.


5K runners will turn around at this point. Encourage them and let them know they are half way done.

When half marathoners are returning, celebrate them BIG. This is the hardest part where they are going to want to quit. Start expecting them at around 9:25 or 9:30am. When they see you on their way back, they will have completed over 11 miles.

## #4 CHEER STOP

Location Address: 56<sup>th</sup> and Riverside

Stand on the west side of the trail (in between the river and walk/run lane). There is a seating area you can use. Do not block the bike lane.



Race for Victory participants will be wearing race bibs. Every participants will pass you twice. Once going to the gathering place and then again, coming back. Cheer for them and pick up any trash they might have (they might hand you a water bottle from their previous stop). When half marathoners are returning, celebrate them BIG. This is the hardest part where they are going to want to quit. Start expecting them at around 9:15am – 9:20am When they see you on their way back, they will have completed over 10 miles.

## #5 WATER STOP / CHEER STOP

Location Address: 4100 Riverside Dr, Tulsa, OK 74105

(River Parks Quiktrip Splash Park)

Park on the north side of the lot.

Set up the table with water bottles and a tent under the trees, on the west side of the trail (walking lane side, not bike lane side)



• TRASH BAGS

Race for Victory participants will be wearing race bibs. Every participant will pass you twice. Once going to the gathering place and then again, coming back. Let the runners have as much water as they want. Cheer for them and pick up any trash they might have. Please don't hand out all of the water to other people passing by or spectators. You don't want to run out of water.



# **#6 CHEER STOP Turnaround Point for Half**

On the south side of the gathering place park, north of the basketball courts. By the north tunnel (closest to downtown), next to swing hill. \*\*Park at the basketball court lot closest to the tunnels.\*\*
