PARTY with PAWS Arts District Walk/Run April 29, 2023

We are excited to have you join us for our 3rd birthday celebration: PARTY with PAWS Arts District Walk/Run in downtown Tulsa. Please remain on the sidewalk or walking path at all times, and obey all traffic signals. Leashed dogs are welcome (but be a good citizen and clean up after your pooch!) Throughout your walk, note *historical plaques* along the sidewalk indicating where black-owned businesses once stood before the 1921 Tulsa Race Massacre.

- 1. Our walk begins at 2 N. Elgin Ave. at Skyline Animal Hospital. Turn left on Archer and follow Archer to the Pedestrian Bridge.
- 2. Turn left on the Pedestrian Bridge: Pass *Center of the Universe*: a circle of concrete, surrounded by bricks, renowned for its unusual acoustic qualities. When you stand on the circle you will hear your voice echoed back to you.
- 3. *Tulsa Union Depot*: Built in 1921, it was the first central train station in the city of Tulsa.
- 4. *Jazz Hall of Fame*: located in the Tulsa Union Depot, it is a nonprofit that honors jazz, blues and gospel musicians in the state of Oklahoma.
- At the bottom of the bridge, you will turn right at E. 1st St. and travel west, crossing S. Main St.
- 6. At S. Boulder Ave. you will turn right and view the **Boulder Bridge art installment** spanning the bridge on both sides, depicting Tulsa's rich cultural history.
- 7. At the bottom of the bridge, you will cross Archer, then turn right, passing through the *archway art installments* on the north side of Archer. You will then cross S. Main St. and travel east on Archer, crossing N. Boston Ave.
- 8. After Crossing N. Boston Ave., you will find yourself in front of *ahha, Tulsa's Arts Center,* where you can use sidewalk chalk to leave your creative mark. You will then continue east, crossing S. Cincinnati Ave.
- 9. Once across S. Cincinnati Ave., you will find yourself walking past exciting restaurants and shops such as Lone Wolf Bhin Ma; Glacier Chocolates; Made, an Indie Emporium of Oklahoma handmade crafts; and Magic City Books, a dog-friendly bookstore owned by the Tulsa Literary Coalition.
- 10. You will then cross N. Detroit Ave. and continue traveling east, until you once again reach N. Elgin Ave., where you will turn right and continue back to Skyline Animal Hospital.

You, and your canine companion, may walk the course 1, 2, or 3 times depending on your stamina! One loop is 1.15 miles. Two loops is 2.30 miles, and three loops is 3.34 miles.
