Course Overview:

This course equips participants with frameworks for methodically encouraging recruitment and ongoing participation in neighborhood initiatives and groups.

- Ensuring the continuity of neighborhood groups

Content:

- How to prepare for and deliver impact reports, including telling a narrative, incorporating data, formatting, and addressing diverse audiences
- Preparing a succession plan for neighborhood association boards
- Documentation for current and onboarding board members, from a calendar of events to asset inventories

- Prepare a succession plan for your neighborhood association leadership.
