Event Description: The longest-running LGBTQ+ pride event in Oklahoma is the Tulsa Pride Festival, organized by Oklahomans for Equality, which is the state's most enduring Pride celebration. It features a free, all-ages festival packed with live music, food vendors, arts and crafts, and community activities.

Central location & community hub: Events typically unfold in the East Village district, anchored by the Dennis R. Neill Equality Center—the fifth-largest LGBTQ+ community center in the U.S.—where many festival activities and gatherings take place.

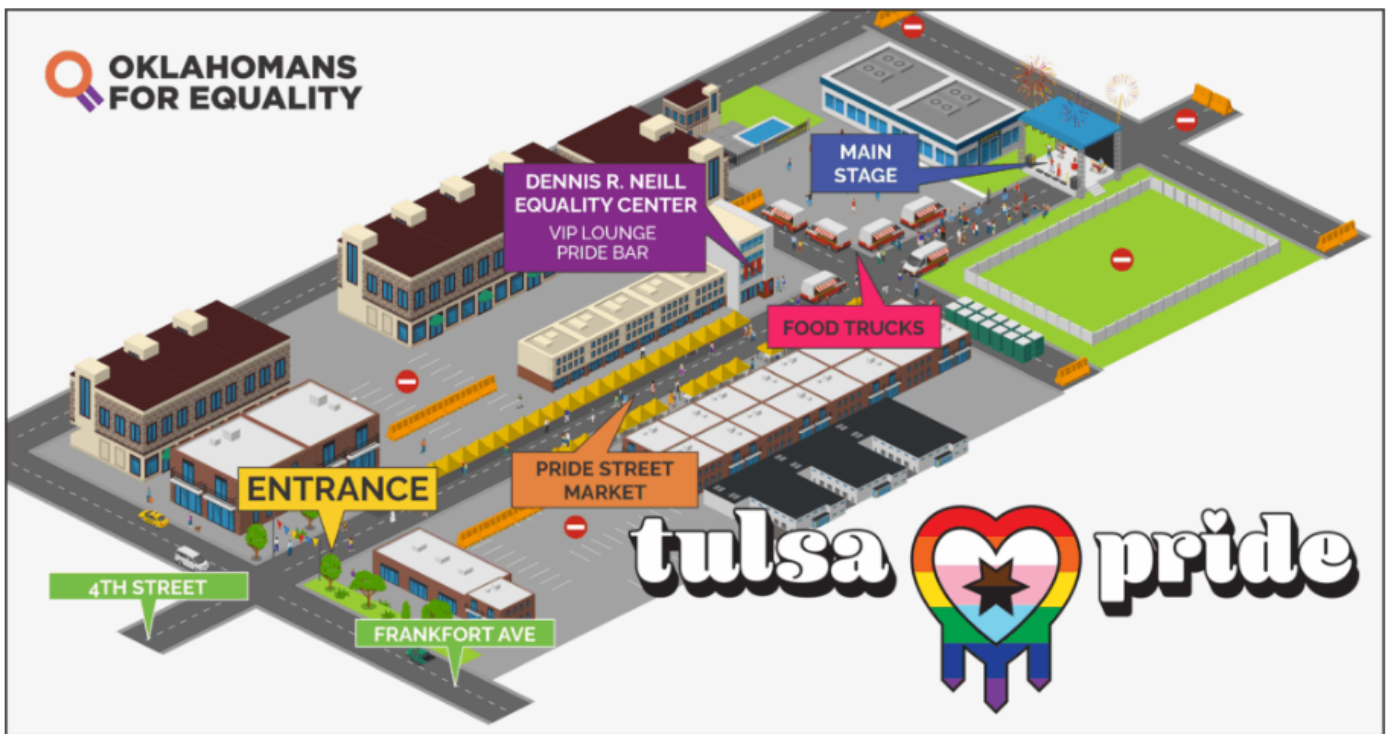

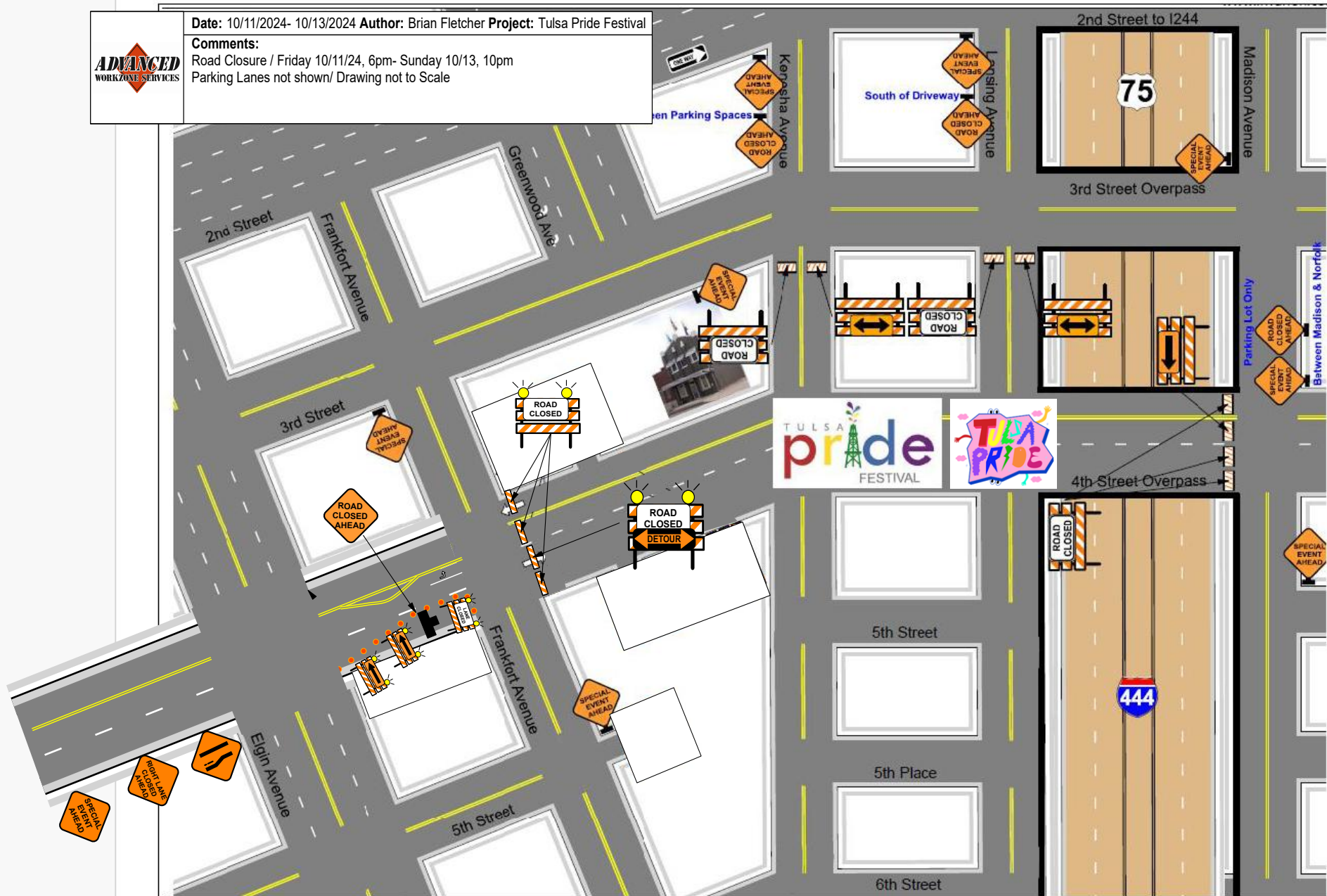
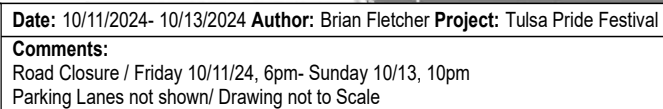
