Roger Acebo from the City of Tulsa Asset Management Department presented the

Acebo noted that this plot of land is located close to O'Brien Park. Acebo noted that Tulsa County would like to take over this piece of land and requested that the City of Tulsa abandon the park use of the land.

Deputy City Administrator Anna America noted that there is no park on the land – it is open green space. The County called America a few years ago and noted that they had been maintaining this location, but it belonged to the City of Tulsa. America noted that the Parks, Culture and Recreation Department supports the potential abandonment of this land for park use.

Savage inquired about the acreage of the plot of land. Acebo noted the land is seven acres.

America asked what the next steps are for this agenda item. Caroline Guerra Wolf with City Legal noted that, if the Board chooses to abandon the land, the item will go to the City Council.
